Kansas Corn Collegiate Academy — This new program gives college students the opportunity to dive deeper into the corn industry. It gives them insights into the opportunities and hurdles that lie ahead of the corn industry and how their future career paths may be impacted. Participating students will also create a capstone project that will relate the information they have learned back to their area of study. Students will participate in a day at the Statehouse in Topeka and Corn Congress in Washington DC. Applicants must be currently enrolled in post-secondary school and still in school through spring semester 2018. This program is now receiving applications through October 31, 2017.
