#### **Spring on the Farm**

### **Summer on the Farm**

Look at the green corn plants!

Corn grows quickly in the summer.

Most corn is watered by rain. Some farmers do not get enough rain.

They use sprinklers to water their fields.

One Little Kernel A corn kernel is a seed. Farmers harvest the kernels in

autumn. The corn kernels are used to feed **livestock**, **DID YOU KNOW?** to make fuel and to make food like tortilla chips and cereal. The kernels are also One kernel can grow into planted to grow more corn plants. one corn plant. The ear of corn on that plant will have about 800 kernels!

### **Autumn on the Farm**

The corn is tall and brown.

The corn kernels are dry and dented.

During harvest, the farmers use a machine called a combine.

It picks the ears of corn off plant and separates the kernels from the ears.

4. The red truck unloads the corn at a grain bin where the corn can be stored. What will they do with all of that corn?
