

Farmers have a lot of equipment to get ready for the year.





















Corn needs water. Most corn grows with water from rain. Some farmers can use sprinklers to water their corn to help it grow.

In the fall, the corn plant is brown and the ears of corn are dry. The farmers use a combine to harvest the corn.

THE REST OF THE PLANT RETURNS TO THE FIELD



Farmers need a lot of help during harvest. The combine driver dumps the corn into a grain cart. The grain cart dumps the corn into a truck. The truck hauls the corn to a bin where it is stored.









Corn has many purposes! Most farmers grow dent corn, also called field corn. It is used to make feed for animals and fuel for cars.










